Message Summary:

Paul is on a mission to seek and save the lost through the preaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Although he is following God’s calling upon his life he is forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach in Asia and Bithynia. Paul has vision and plans of his own yet was sensitive to the leading of the Spirit and submits to the God’s will immediately.
