Peter's encouragement to believers who are suffering (1--2)

1. *Remember* what God has already done for you:

- God the Father has **elected** you because He loves you
- God the Spirit has **sanctified** you, putting you IN CHRIST
- God the Son has **shed His blood** for you, enabling you to be justified, sanctified, and glorified

2. *Receive* what God offers you:

• Grace & Peace

God has **predestined** every believer to:

- receive every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places
- become holy and blameless
- become adopted as sons/daughters
- be redeemed through Jesus' blood and receive forgiveness of all sins
- be lavished in His grace
- be united with Him forever

Peter's message to suffering Christians

"Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father"



3. *Repeatedly* praise God, because:

- He is the reason we have been born again, according to His great mercy
- He has given you a living (future) hope through Jesus' resurrection
- He has **kept** for you a heavenly inheritance
- He has guaranteed that His children (believers by faith) will be guarded by His power

1 Pet 1:3-4 (ESV)

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to His great mercy, He has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (4)to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you"

1 Pet. 1:3-5 (ESV)

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to His great mercy, He has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (4)to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, (5) who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time."
