
A Christian Wife's Submission To Her Husband

1 Peter 3:1-6






Unity and Diversity in Marriage ('Trinity' model)

"Submit one to another" (Eph. 5:1) = <u>unity</u> of husband and wife (*models the unity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit*)

"Wives submit to your husbands" (1 Pet. 3:1) = <u>diversity</u> of husband and wife (*models the diverse/unique roles of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit*)
