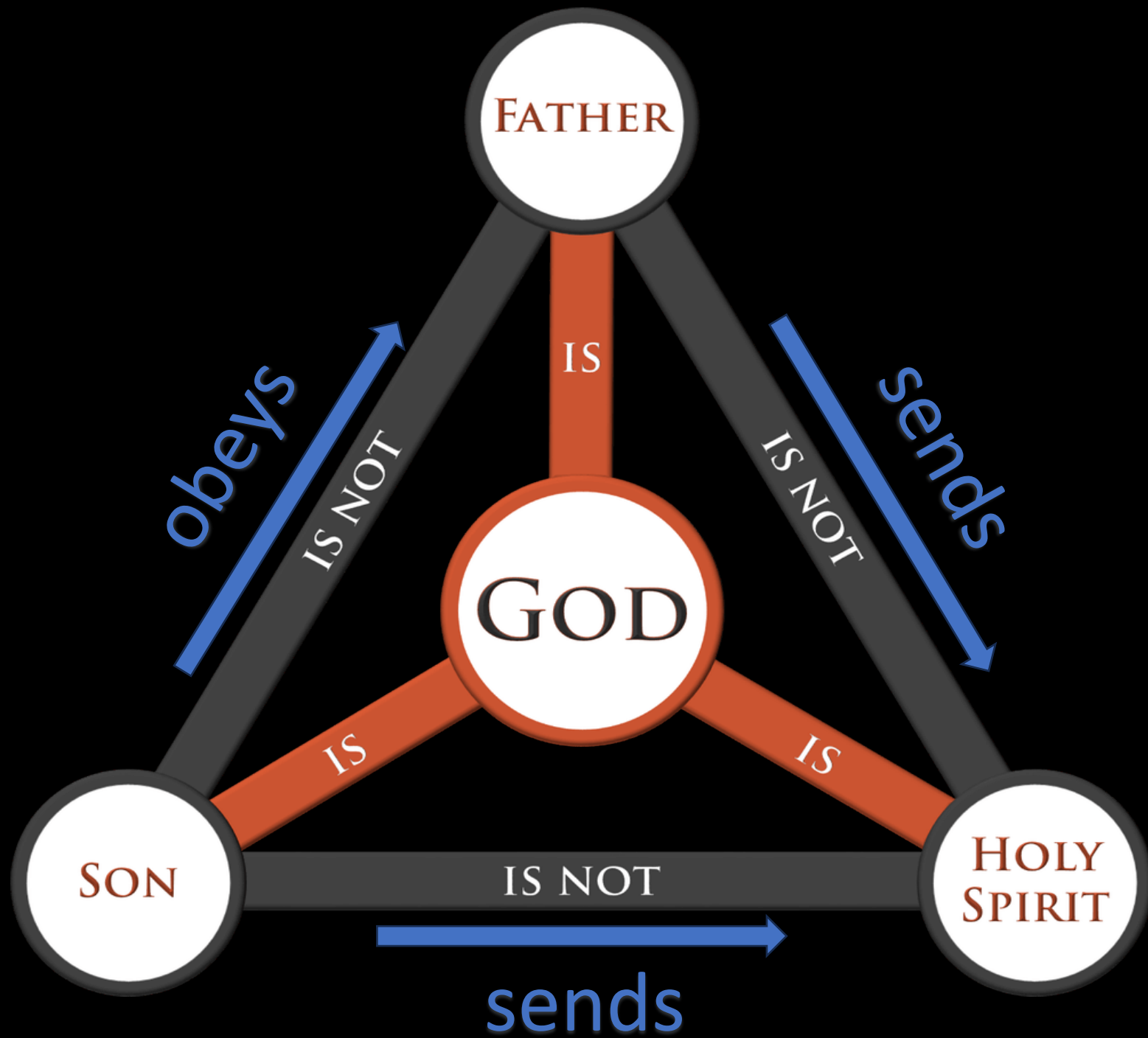


A Christian Wife's Submission To Her Husband

1 Peter 3:1-6





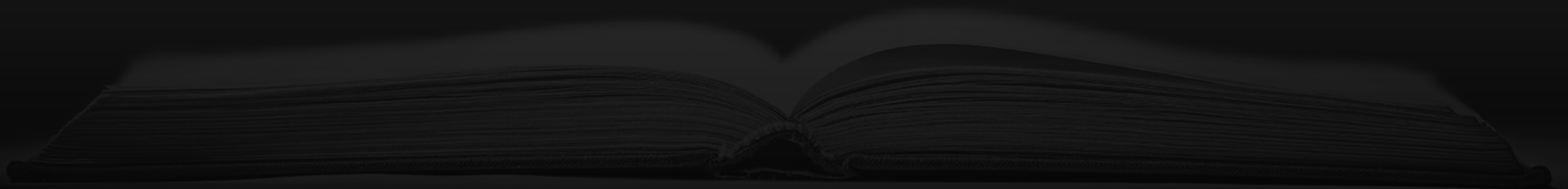
Unity and Diversity in Marriage ('Trinity' model)

“Submit one to another” (Eph. 5:1) = unity of husband and wife (*models the unity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit*)

“Wives submit to your husbands” (1 Pet. 3:1) = diversity of husband and wife (*models the diverse/unique roles of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit*)

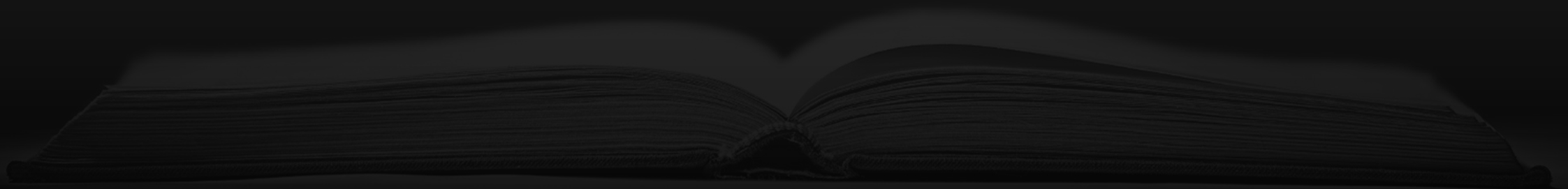
Gen. 1:27 (ESV)

“So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female he created them.”



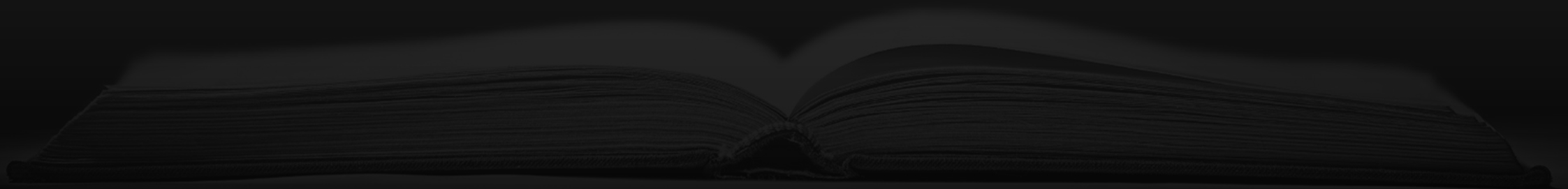
Gen. 2:18 (ESV)
