## **Reflection & Discussion**

- 1. In 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 3:6 Peter exhorts a submissive wife to "not fear anything that is frightening". What does he mean by that? What other Scriptures would encourage a wife to *not fear* what she may perceive as *frightening*?
- 2. Paul calls on husbands and wives to submit to *one-another*, yet Peter calls on wives to submit to their husbands. Is this a contradiction? How would you explain the 'similarities' and 'differences' of marital submission?
- 3. Husbands are called to love their wives as Christ loves His church:
  - a. How does Jesus love His church?
  - b. Consider/discuss the question: how does a man achieve this monumental call? (What might hinder him? What key biblical concepts should he focus on? ...etc.)
