Reflection & Discussion

- 1. How would you summarize the meaning of the Parable of the Sower?

 - b. What might hinder you (i.e. what might make you like one of the other soils in the Parable?)
- 2. Peter exhorts husbands to honor their wives:
 - a. How would you define 'honor' biblically?
 - b. What does honoring his wife look like practically?
 - c. Consider/discuss other uses of 'honor' in the Bible (especially 1st Peter 2:17)
- 3. In verse 7, husbands should consider their wives as "weaker vessels". Consider/discuss Peter's use of that term.
- 4. 2 reasons are given to motivate men to be godly husbands: the wife is a *fellow heir*, and so that his prayers aren't *hindered*. Consider/discuss the meaning of those. What other Scriptures support them?
