Reflection & Discussion

(From last week):

- 1. Peter exhorts husbands to *honor* their wives:

 - c. Consider/discuss other uses of 'honor' in the Bible (especially 1st Peter 2:17)
- 2. In verse 7, husbands should consider their wives as "weaker vessels". Consider/discuss Peter's use of that term.
- 3. 2 reasons are given to motivate men to be godly husbands: the wife is a *fellow heir*, and so that his prayers aren't *hindered*. Consider/discuss the meaning of those. What other Scriptures support them?
