**Reflection & Discussion**

1. John refers to the church as being in the “last days”:
  - a. Where else in the Bible do we find this kind of language used.
  - b. Why is it significant and impactful in a Christian’s life?
  
2. In verse 18, John declares that “many antichrists have come”.
  - a. How does the church protect itself from the influence of ‘antichrists’?
  - b. In verse 19 he says “they went out from us”: how should God’s people respond when someone close *abandons truth*?
  
3. Consider where we are *culturally, politically, and socially*: how does a Christian maintain adherence to truth and obedience to Christ in such a hostile climate?
