## **Reflection & Discussion**

- 1. Peter emphasizes the *certain judgment* of false teachers, along with the *certain rescue* of God's people:
  - a. What passages in the Bible emphasize that unbelievers/evildoers will *indeed* face God's judgment?
  - b. What passages emphasize that God's people will be rescued from His judgment?
- 2. God's people are *blessed* when they walk by faith:
  - a. What does it mean to 'walk by faith'?
  - b. What are the blessings that God bestows upon His people who walk by faith?
- 3. Christians who choose *not* to walk by faith are depriving themselves of God's blessings. Have an open discussion about what it means to *not* walk by faith. (How does it affect them? How does it 'affect' the Lord? Why is it dangerous? ...etc.)
