

About our Purpose

Our JWalker's Club is our Bible Memory Program specifically developed for 1st-5th graders. Following Colossians 2: 6-7, "As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith," we would like to support you in guiding your child's walk with Christ. Throughout this two-year program, your child will learn several portions of scripture that will help shape their faith and ultimately encourage them to surrender their lives to Christ.

We have selected key Bible passages that focus on God's love for us, salvation, prayer, obedience and praise. It is our hope that through this program you and your children can work together as a family to memorize Scripture.



We are excited to have your child here with us and we pray that we will be able to build on the foundation you are laying at home. As your child memorizes God's Word, he/she will be able to live out 2 Timothy 2:15, "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." It is our earnest prayer that you participate with us by encouraging your child to learn the Scriptures and that God may richly bless your family as you study together.

Getting started (1st -4th grade only)

Weekly verses

Verses are assigned weekly for children and parents to work on together. These verses must be recited on the date they are assigned to receive credit. (See the schedule on pages 4-9) If you are going to be absent,

you can make up the verse up to one week late. Children who recite weekly verses will earn \$10 Bible Bucks. If parents recite the weekly verse, children will earn an additional \$10 Bible Bucks.

bonus passages

Bonus Passages (see page 12) are for 1st-4th graders and add an extra challenge to the JWalker's Club. Children who complete the Bonus Passages, in addition to the weekly verses, will be honored during our Medal Ceremony in the Main Sanctuary in June. They will also receive an invitation to our special JWalker's Club Celebration Party in May.

Children can recite Bonus Passages any Sunday throughout the year. All Bonus Passages must be completed by Sunday April 28th.

Children will earn \$30 Bible Bucks for every completed Bonus passage.



GOLD Medal Challenge

5th graders only have the option of participating in the 5th Grade Gold Medal Challenge. The Gold Medal Challenge requires 5th graders to memorize 18 Challenge Passages during their 5th Grade year.

They can recite the passages at the Kids Ministry Table at any time during the year, when they feel ready. Fifth graders should complete at least 3 passages a month to finish the Gold Medal Challenge on time.

Fifth graders who complete the Gold Medal Challenge will be honored with a Gold Medal Ceremony in June. They will also be invited to the special JWalkers celebration in May.

They must complete all 18 passages by Sunday April 28th. See pages 10-11 for a list of the passages. 5th Graders will earn \$30 Bible Bucks for every completed Bonus passage.




