"You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons

believe—and shudder!"

Luke 8:32 (ESV)

"Now a large herd of pigs was feeding there on the hillside, and they begged Him to let them enter these. So He gave them permission."

Mark 1:24-25 (ESV)

"'What have You to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God.' (25)But Jesus rebuked him, saying, 'Be silent, and come out of him!'"

Matthew 12:43-45 (ESV)

"When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, but finds none. (44)Then it says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when it comes, it finds the house empty, swept, and put in order. (45)Then it goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that person is worse than the first. So also will it be with this evil generation."

According to the Bible, DEMONS:

- 8. Are invisible
 - Future: seen as gruesome
- 9. Exceed humans in:
 - Strength (not omnipotent)
 - Intelligence (not omniscient)
 - Movement (not omnipresent)
- 10. Utilize signs/miracles to deceive

"He lived among the tombs. And no one could bind him anymore, not even with a chain, (4) for he had often been bound with shackles and chains, but he wrenched the chains apart, and he broke the shackles in pieces. No one had the strength to subdue him."

"For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect."

2 Thessalonians 2:9 (ESV)

Revelation 16:13-14 (ESV)
