


Dedicated To God & His Ways

Original names/meanings (Dan. 1:6)

| Hebrew Name | Meaning |
|-------------|---------------------|
| Daniel | God is my judge |
| Hananiah | Yahweh is gracious |
| Mishael | Who is what God is? |
| Azariah | Yahweh has helped |

Changed names/meanings (Dan. 1:7)

| Babylonian Name | Meaning |
|-----------------|------------------------|
| Belteshazzar | Lady protect the king |
| Shadrach | I am fearful of God |
| Meshach | I am of little account |
| Abednego | Servant of Nebo |

Judah's conquering in 3 stages:

- 605: Daniel and a few others (Dan. 1:1)
- 597: Ezekiel and majority (2 Kings 24:10-16)
- 586: Jerusalem, Temple destroyed; remnant taken (2 Kings 25:1-21)



Neo-Babylonian Empire

Nabopolassar, Nebuchadnezzar II,
Nabonidus, Belshazzar (625-539 BC)
