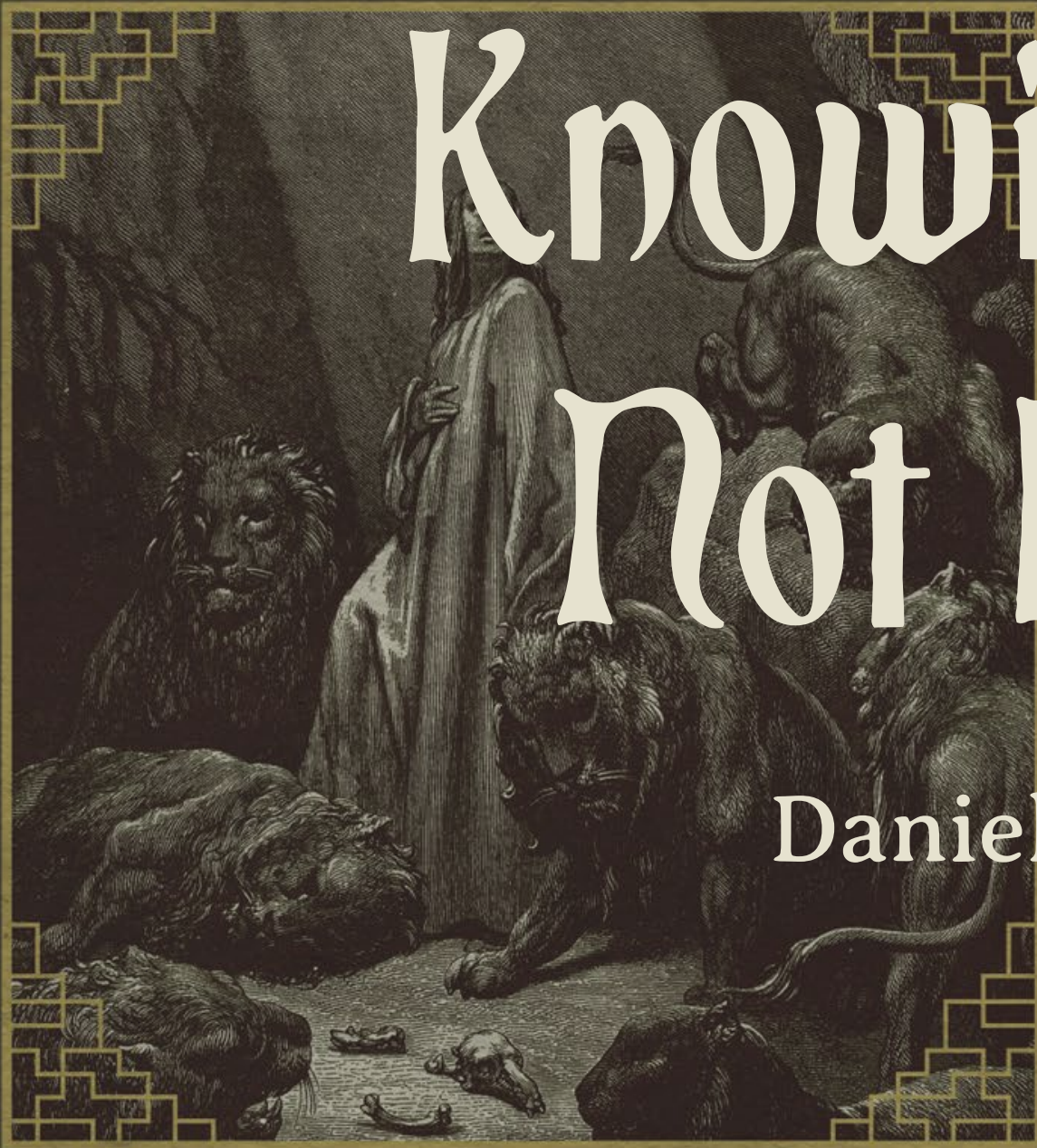

539 BC

Son of Nabonidus
Appointed as co-regent

605 BC

Defeats Egypt
at Carchemish;
becomes ruler
of Babylon

two years

556 BC
Rules only
two months



539 BC
Known for restoring
