

Rev. 7:16-17 (ESV)

"They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any scorching heat. (17) For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and He will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

Rev. 14:13 (ESV)

"And I heard a voice from heaven saying, 'Write this:
Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.'
'Blessed indeed,' says the Spirit, 'that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them!'"

1 Cor. 13:12 (ESV)

"For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face.

Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known."

1 Cor. 13:13 (ESV)

"So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love."

1 Cor. 15:42-44 (ESV)

"So is it with the resurrection of the dead. What is sown is perishable; what is raised is imperishable. (43)It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness; it is raised in power. (44)It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body."

Php. 3:8-9 (ESV)

"Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For His sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ (9) and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith"
