1 Samuel 16:13–14 (ESV)

"Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers. And the Spirit of the LORD rushed upon David from that day forward. And Samuel rose up and went to Ramah. **(14)** Now the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and a harmful spirit from the LORD tormented him."



Psalm 2:8–9 (ESV)

"Ask of Me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession. (9) You shall break them with a rod of iron and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel."

Scope:	Universal (Ps. 103:19)	Earthly (Dan. 2:35, 44-45)
Rule:	God rules directly (Dan. 4:17)	God rules indirectly (Ps. 2:6-9)
When:	Always (Ps. 93:1-2)	In response to faith (Ex. 19:5-6; Matt. 3:2; 11:2-6, 14; 23:27-29)
