## Deuteronomy 32:17 (ESV)

"They sacrificed to demons that were no gods, to gods they had never known, to new gods that had come recently, whom your fathers had never dreaded."

## Ephesians 3:8-10 (NLT)

(9)I was chosen to explain to everyone this mysterious plan that God, the Creator of all things, had kept secret from the beginning. # Gentry

“That is, we believe that in the unfolding of the plan of God in history, the Christian Church is the very fruition of the redemptive purpose of God. As such, the multi-racial, international Church of Jesus Christ supersedes racial, national Israel as the focus of the kingdom of God. Indeed, we believe that the Church becomes "the Israel of God" (Gal. 6:16), the "seed of Abraham" (Gal. 3:29), "the circumcision" (Phil. 3:3), the "temple of God" (Eph. 2:19-22), and so forth. We believe that Jew and Gentile are eternally merged into a "new man" in the Church of Jesus Christ (Eph. 2:12- 18). What God hath joined together let no man put asunder!”



## Price

“Replacement Theology: a theological perspective that teaches that the Jews have been rejected by God and are no longer God’s Chosen People. Those who hold to this view disavow any ethnic future for the Jewish people in connection with the biblical covenants, believing that their spiritual destiny is either to perish or become a part of the new religion that superseded Judaism (whether Christianity or Islam).

Perhaps [this] definition provides some insight into what an American Muslim and American Christian have in common. They both believe that Israel is permanently replaced by the church and that the church is the Israel of God from Galatians 6:16.”

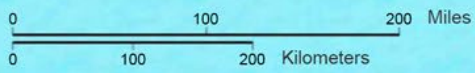
## Galatians 6:16 (ESV)

“If Abraham can have Gentiles as his "spiritual seed," why cannot there be a spiritual Israel? In fact, Christians are called by the name "Israel" : "And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy by upon them, and upon the Israel of God" (Gal. 6:16)”

## Galatians 6:16 – NOT prooftext for Replacement Theology

- ‘kai’ = “and” (*continuative*, not *appositional*)
- Paul would not have used “kai” (simpler understanding)
- “Israel” always means (national, ethnic) Israel
- First record of “Israel” as “church”: 160 A.D.
- Why place a ‘new truth’ at the end of his letter?
