Exodus 8:22 (ESV)

"But on that day I will set apart the land of Goshen, where My people dwell, so that no swarms of flies shall be there, that you may know that I am the LORD in the midst of the earth."

Exodus 9:4 (ESV)

"But the LORD will make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and the livestock of Egypt, so that nothing of all that belongs to the people of Israel shall die."

"When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne. (10)They cried out with a loud voice, 'O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before You will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?' (11)Then they were each given a white robe and told to rest a little longer, until the number of their fellow servants and their brothers should be complete, who were to be killed as they themselves had been."

Rev. 17:6 (ESV)

“And I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints,
the blood of the martyrs of Jesus.”

Rev. 18:24 (ESV)

“And in her was found the blood of prophets and of saints,
and of all who have been slain on earth.”



John 14:1-3 (ESV)

“Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in Me. (2)In My Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? (3)And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also.”

"For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. (17) Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. (18) Therefore encourage one another with these words."

Titus 2:13 (ESV)

"waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ"



"and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, in which she is to be nourished for 1,260 days."



Isa. 41:17-20 (ESV)

"When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue is parched with thirst, I the LORD will answer them; I the God of Israel will not forsake them. (18)I will open rivers on the bare heights, and fountains in the midst of the valleys. I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water. (19)I will put in the wilderness the cedar, the acacia, the myrtle, and the olive. I will set in the desert the cypress, the plane and the pine together, (20)that they may see and know, may consider and understand together, that the hand of the LORD has done this, the Holy One of Israel has created it."

"And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that I should lose nothing of all that He has given Me, but raise it up on the last day. (40) For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in Him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day... (44) No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws Him. And I will raise him up on the last day."

Do you believe this?' (27) She said to him, 'Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who is coming into the world.'"

Eph. 3:3-6 (ESV)

"how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have written briefly. (4)When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ, (5)which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit. (6)This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel."

“...His body, that is, the church...(26)the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to His saints.”

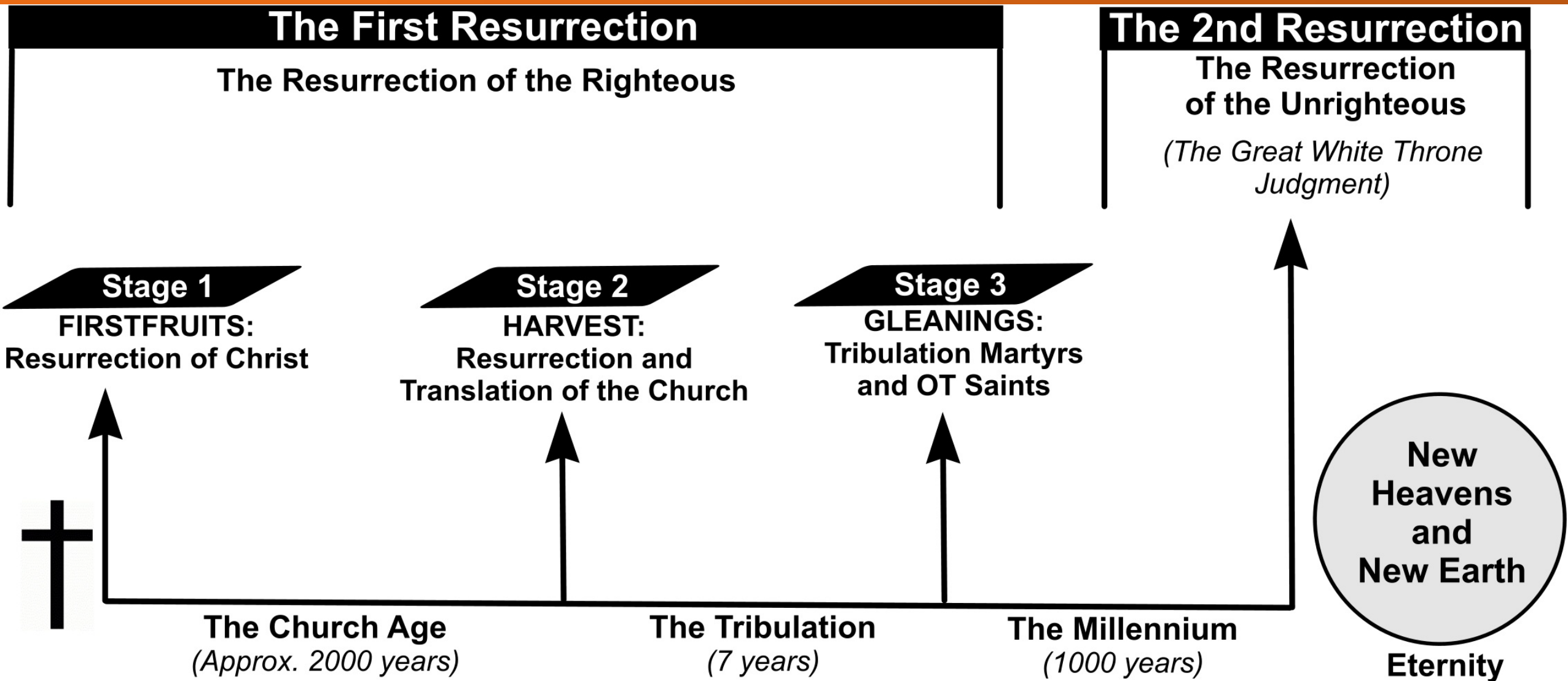


“Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed”

2 Pet. 3:1-4 (ESV)

"This is now the second letter that I am writing to you, beloved. In both of them I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder, (2)that you should remember the predictions of the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior through your apostles, (3)knowing this first of all, that scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires. (4)They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation."

2 Pet 3:9-10 (ESV)

"The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. (10) But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed."

2 Pet. 3:14,17-18 (ESV)

“Therefore, beloved, since you are waiting for these, be diligent to be found by him without spot or blemish, and at peace... (17) You therefore, beloved, knowing this beforehand, take care that you are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose your own stability. (18) But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.”

1 Cor. 15:58 (ESV)

"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."
