The importance of the supernatural conception of Christ:


1. Fulfills Old Testament prophecy
2. Validates Jesus as the singular Savior of the world
 - He is fully God and fully man ('hypostatic union')
 - He is eternal
 - He is sinless
 - Confirms His bodily atonement
 - ...He must be perfect
 - Bypasses Jeconaih's curse, yet fulfils the Davidic covenant
3. To authenticate the New Testament

The *humanity* of Jesus

1. Worked (Mark 6:3)
2. Hungered (Matt. 4:2)
3. Tired (John 4:6)
4. Troubled (John 12:27)
5. Thirsted (John 19:28)
6. Saddened (John 11:35—"Jesus wept.")
7. Agonized (Luke 22:44)
8. Tempted (Luke 4; Heb. 4:15)


The *deity* of Jesus (John 1)
