## **Reflection & Discussion**

- (From last week) In James 4, he explains that quarrelling and fighting are the result of believers yielding to their old natures, seeking their own wills rather than God's:
  - a. Where else in the Bible is this lesson taught?
  - b. How do we guard against pursuing our own wills rather than God's?
  - c. What are the dangers associated with Christians who cause division within the church? What *biblical counsel* would you offer to Christians involved in a 'quarrel' with others?
- 2. (From last week) Have an open discussion about persistent prayer: What does it mean? How long should I pray about a specific want/need? What if I'm not getting the answer I want? ...etc.
- 3. In verse 4 James exhorts believers not to *befriend* the world:
  - a. What does it mean to be a "friend of the world"?
  - b. How do we guard against friendship with the world?
