Reflection & Discussion

1. Consider the Abrahamic Covenant (Gen. 12:1-3, Romans 11:1,29):
 - a. How do these verses solidify the case that God isn't 'finished' with Israel yet?
 - b. Why do you think many Christians today believe that the church has replaced (superseded) Israel?
 - c. Where else in the Bible is it clear that the *church* and Israel are distinct?

2. Even in Israel's rebellion, God honored His promise not to abandon Israel:
 - a. Give some examples of this from Scripture.
 - b. What aspect of God is 'most exemplified' by His faithfulness to Israel?

3. How do we answer criticisms such as: “How can you support Israel considering how *godless* the nation is?”
 - a. In what *practical* ways can Christians show their support for Israel?
